



Salad Days Artist-in-Residence

One artist is selected by jury for a three-month residency beginning in June and running through August. The Salad Days Artist is commissioned to produce 500 plates from our indigenous earthenware for Watershed's annual July fundraising event, SALAD DAYS.

Duration: 3 months – May 27 – August 31, 2012

Compensation and benefits: The artist is provided a private room with bath and all meals during their residency, a large studio, materials and firings; other benefits available to all past Watershed residents, such as opportunities to sell work at events and invitations to exhibit in group shows.

Salad Days Artist plates and works will be featured in print and on-line publications of Watershed, in addition to local and regional advertisements and press.
